



FULL-TIME JH/HS PHYSICS INSTRUCTOR

Seeking a full-time 7-12th grade science instructor for the 2019-2020 school year at Liberty Common High School in Fort Collins, Colorado – a Poudre School District charter school dedicated to Core Knowledge principles and college-preparatory instruction. The school currently enrolls over 500 junior-high and high-school students.

This is done through parental choice, partnership with teachers, and student acceptance of responsibility for his/her academic effort.

The full-time science instructor has responsibility for program delivery of the science-instructional program for junior-high and high-school students in cooperation with the school's existing Science Department. These classes include 8th-grade Core Knowledge science, 11th/12th grade general physics, and AP Physics II. Applicants should be dedicated to strong skills- and knowledge-based curriculum as well as high student achievement.

Minimum Requirements:

- Desire and willingness to learn about Liberty's history and philosophy and to uphold and promote the mission and values of the school.
- BA/BS in science or related discipline, or equivalent combination of relevant education and experience. Content knowledge is essential.
- Ability and willingness to teach Core Knowledge science, general physics, and AP Physics.
- Demonstrated effective classroom teaching ability.

Preferred Characteristics:

- Understanding of Liberty Common School's history and a commitment to maintaining and promoting the school's mission and values.
- Experience and proficiency with Core Knowledge science, general physics, and AP Physics instruction/direction.
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively in multiple teams.
- MS/MA in science, or equivalent combination of relevant education and experience.
- Other relevant or related experience including expertise in engineering.
