Overview: Chapter 65: Religion and the State; Pliny to Trajan; Review

Description:

- Continuation of studies – noun, verb endings reviewed extensively
- Full declensions of nouns (1st, 2nd, and 3rd Declensions, neuter gender)
- Full conjugations of verbs (1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Conjugations) – all six tenses
- Prose Composition – direct objects, prepositional phrases, ablative of time/means/manner/cause, limited vocabulary, adjectives, all tenses, genitive case (possession), indirect objects, passive voice, relative clauses, irregular verbs, participles, subjunctive mood, gerundives, gerunds, future passive participles
- Translation, readings in book, basic translation
- Passive Voice and Subjunctive Mood – forms, grammar, etc.
- Extensive History – the Late Republic/Early Empire
- Must-Know Vocabulary
- Writers: Asconius, Cicero, Augustus, Pliny, Trajan
- Introduction to Linguistics, Greek, Spanish – study of language in general, relationship of Latin to Spanish
