

## Liberty Common Junior High/High School Supply List - 2011-2012 School Year

### General Supplies:

- The length of all binders must be less than 11 inches, or they will not fit in the lockers.
- Locker shelf may be desirable, easy fix: cut and bring 3 pieces of plywood (1 piece – 11 7/8" x 10 13/16", 2 pieces 14 7/16" x 10 13/16").
- One dress code sweatshirt without a hood: order forms available in front office on shirt display shelf.
- 3 boxes of tissues delivered to your homeroom teacher.
- 2 binders at least 1 inch or Trapper-type (one for periods 1-4, one for periods 5-8).
- 18-20 3-hole tab dividers (for divisions between and within classes).
- 1 TI-30XA scientific calculator for Economics, Algebra 1, Geometry, Chemistry, and AP Chemistry. Algebra 2 requires a graphing calculator (see below). Instructions will only be provided for the recommended calculator. TI-84 is required for Physics.
- 1 pencil pouch (or 1 for each binder)
- 1 eraser
- 4-6 book covers (any kind that covers the entirety of the book)
- 3 or more red correcting pens (for English and other classes such as Biology or Pre-Algebra)
- 1 pencil box containing: glue sticks, markers, scissors, colored pencils (12 count)
- 1 year supply of blue or black pens and pencils
- Notebook paper-preferably college ruled (a yearlong supply)
- 3x5 cards for term paper in second semester
- 1 assignment notebook - it must fit the following specifications:
  - 4x8 inches to 8x11 inches in size
  - Rigid cover to attach hall passes (passes must be stapled to it)
  - entire week visible when open, enough room to write assignments for 8 classes each day

### Spanish:

- Spanish-English dictionary (for home use): recommended publishers are Merriam-Webster, Oxford, VOX, and Webster's
- 2 inch binder
- package of at least 8 dividers

**All Engineering Classes:** Headphones

**Technology:** a USB flash drive (recommended, not required) – any size

### All Art Classes:

- Sketchbook (Spiral binding, at least 70 pages, 8.5"x 11")

### Photography Classes (Need by 2<sup>nd</sup> week of school):

- 35mm SLR Manual Camera, Digital Camera with manual setting option, USB Flash Drive

### Graphic Design:

- Digital camera, USB Flash Drive

### **English/Composition Supplies:**

- 2 inch binder used only for English or Composition
- 3 nice blue or black writing pens and 3 nice red grading pens
- 5 dividers for 3-ring binder
- Composition II class – A Pocket Style Manual by Diana Hacker (inexpensive online)

### **Math Supplies:**

- NO CALCULATORS
- College ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- 1 protractor
- 1 ruler (inches and centimeters)
- Pencils and red pen
- 2" inch binder w/3 dividers

#### **Geometry:**

- Scientific calculator (***TI-30XA***)
- "Locking" compass
- Protractor and Scissors
- Ruler (inches and centimeters)
- College ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- ¼ inch grid loose leaf graph paper
- Pencils or mechanical pencil and red pens
- Binder or folder

#### **Algebra I:**

- Scientific calculator (***TI-30XA***)
- Ruler (inches and centimeters)
- College ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- ¼ inch grid loose leaf graph paper
- Pencils or mechanical pencil and pens
- Binder or folder

#### **Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, Calculus AB/BC, and Physics:**

- Graphing calculator (***TI-83*** or ***TI-84***, which are allowed on the SAT, ACT and CSAP). TI-83s can be checked out.
- Ruler (inches and centimeters)
- College ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- ¼ inch grid loose leaf graph paper
- Pencils or mechanical pencil and pens
- Binder or folder

### **Science:**

- Metric ruler
- Red pens, blue or black pens, pencils
- Extra large book cover

### **AP Biology:**

- 3 ring binder for AP biology only
- Very large book cover
- Pack of notecards to make flashcards
- More required supplies might be added during the year
